Tees - Hitting for Power: Has the tendency to tie himself up. Wraps bat, dips back shoulder, works up through the ball.

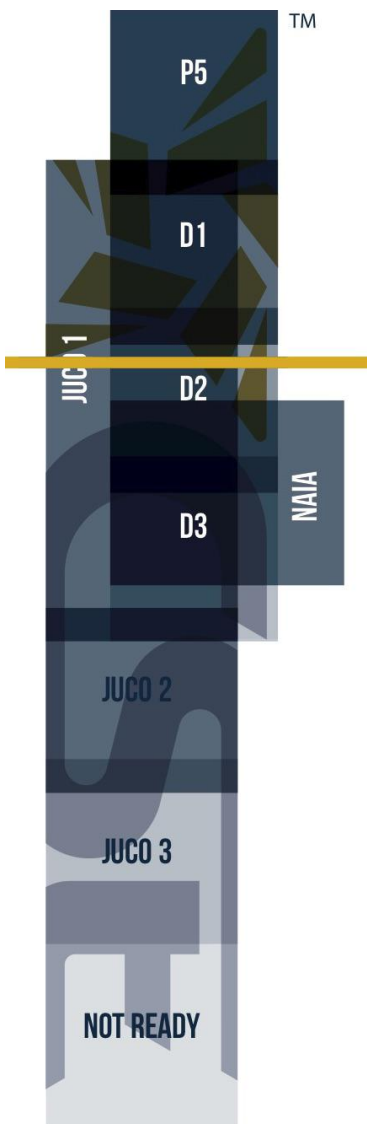

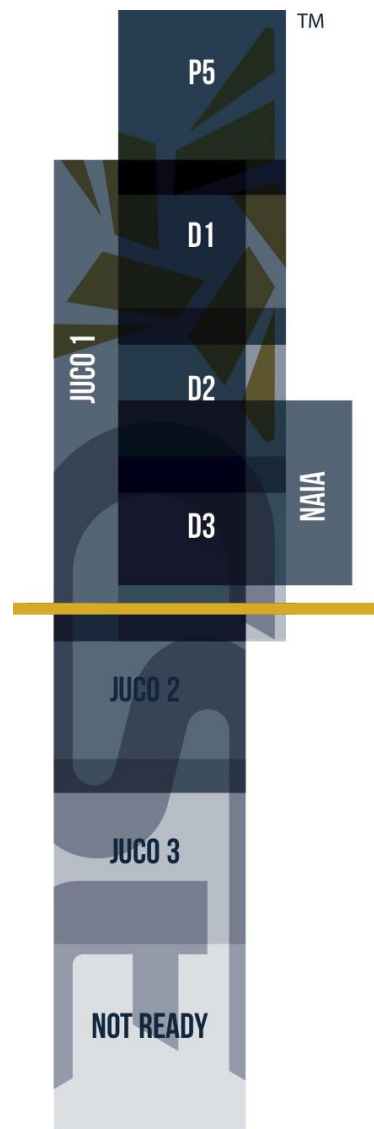

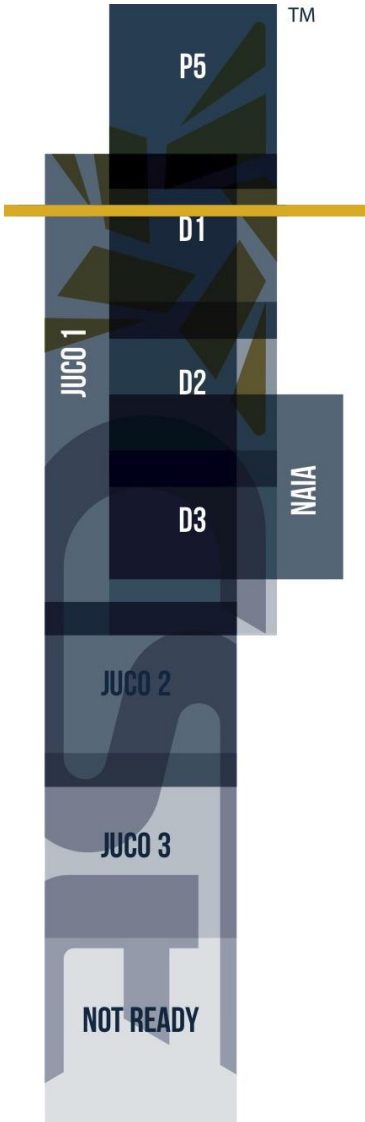

Drill Evaluation

Throws to Bases - Throwing Ability: Above average ability to throw to bases from the field. Anticipation has a lot to do with his ability.

Throws to Bases - Glove Work: Good load on ground ball. Shows accuracy on throw from center to home on a bobble on a play to the plate. Looked to throw to second base instead of throwing it to the plate. Displays above average arm strength.

Dropsteps - Footwork: Has all the tools to do well. Tends to lose focus during instruction time but regained it later in the day. Stay focused throughout the day.

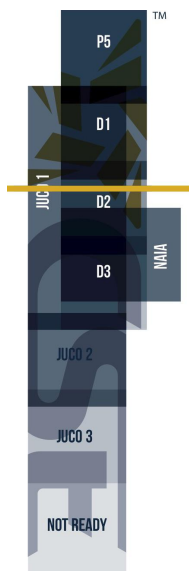
