
- Over 7.5 Million High School Athletes

1. Intro Letters / Questionnaires - NO

2. Emails

- Camp invite or questionnaire emails Sometimes
- Personal emails from a coach Maybe
- 3. Personal Letters Maybe

4. Phone Calls – YES

- Calls to coaches first, then student-athletes & parents
- 5. In House Visits / Official Trip offer YES

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
